**THURSDAY, 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2010**

**Arrival to Zagreb and accommodation in the hotel "Dubrovnik"**

Your hotel „Dubrovnik“ \*\*\*\* is situated in the main Zagreb square called "Ban Jelacic Square" (the address: Ljudevita Gaja 1, 10 000 Zagreb).

This ideal location can serve as your gateway to the very heart of the city. It is 18 km away from Zagreb airport.

**From the airport:**

We recommend using the **taxi service** (taxi fare to the hotel is about 180-230 kn (kuna) (approx. 25 – 32 EUR) . You may also use the Croatia Airlines bus service to the Main bus station (about 20 minutes drive, 35 kn (approx. 5 EUR) per ticket. From the Main **bus station** you can take a tram number 6 to Ban Jelačić Square (about 10 minutes drive, 10 kn (approx. 1,4 EUR) per ticket).

**Arriving by car:**

Hotel **parking** is available at Praška street, about 100m from the hotel. Make sure to reserve your parking spot in advance. The price of parking is 100 Kn/day on weekdays (approx. 14 EUR) and 80 Kn/day on weekends (approx. 11 EUR).

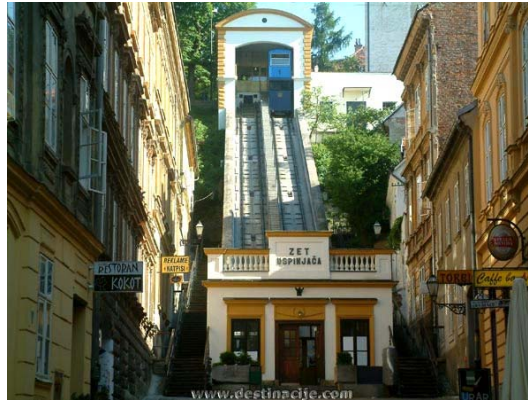

## **WHOLE DAY EXCURSION TO THE ADRIATIC COAST**

### **VRBNIK AND OPATIJA**



During this whole day excursion we will visit the largest island of the Adriatic, which has been a monument to life and culture for over two thousand years - "The golden island of Krk" and we will explore the charm of the oldest touristic town on the Adriatic coast - Opatija!

Departure from the hotel is planned at 8:30 am, driving toward Crikvenica. In Crikvenica we will take a boat to the island of Krk, actually to Vrbnik, town built on the rock, about 48 m from the level of the sea, home of the famous wine, "*Vrbnicka zlahtina*". We will have the opportunity to taste homemade prosciutto, cheese, wine and excellent fish menu in a unique local tavern! After Vrbnik, our journey will continue toward beautiful Opatija where we will have time to walk "*lungomare*" - along the sea promenade, or to drink coffee in famous coffee shop. Our dinner will be held in a traditional restaurant in the vicinity of Opatija where we will be able to taste the local specialities. Return to hotel late in the evening.
