A Venue with Purpose

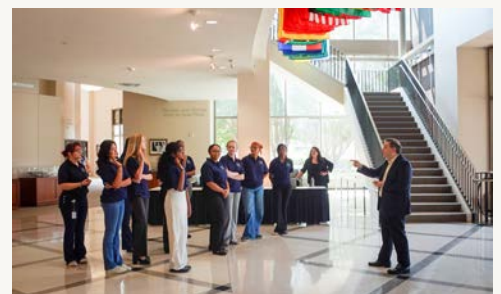

Jaworski & Hall Auditorium

A unique environment rarely available in traditional event venues



At a Glance

- Size: 5,120 sq. ft.
- Capacity: up to 200 participants
- Layout: auditorium setting with fixed tables and adjustable rolling chairs

Technology & Features

- Full A/V system for presenters:
 - Touch-screen control panel
 - Projector and audience screen
 - Wired, handheld, lav, and panelist mics
 - Confidence monitor for presenters
 - Laptop connectivity
- Participant mics and laptop charging
- Adjustable lighting and spotlights
- Fabric-wall for quality acoustics
- ADA compliant with wheelchair elevator access to presentation area

About the Space

This auditorium supports interactive lecture-and-response educational experiences.

An additional feature is its ability to replicate a courtroom with minor reconfiguration. The judge's bench, jury box, jury deliberation room, and witness stand all support actual trials or legal training.

A flexible space designed for interactive learning with adaptable formats

- Full A/V system for presenters:
 - Touch-screen control panel
 - Drop-down screen and ceiling-mounted projector
 - Laptop connection for presentations
 - Podium with integrated microphone
 - Two handheld mics
- Configurable table layouts support group work and instruction

About the Space

This classroom is designed for flexibility, allowing the layout to shift between structured instruction and open-format use.

The room's two-person tables can be arranged for collaborative learning or reconfigured into theater-style seating to accommodate larger groups.

The space supports a range of training and meeting environments for programs that require both presentation and participant interaction.

A tiered lecture space designed for presentations and structured learning

- Size: 1,936 sq. ft.
- Capacity: up to 60 participants (tiered seating)
- Layout: three U-shaped tiered rows; fixed

Technology & Features

- Full A/V system for presenters:
 - Touch-screen control panel
 - Drop-down screen, ceiling-mounted projector, and confidence monitor
 - Laptop connection for presentations
 - Podium with integrated microphone
 - Mics: wired, handheld, or lavalier (max two)
- Whiteboard
- Ceiling-mounted participant mics and individual laptop charging

About the Space

This lecture hall features tiered seating that ensures strong sightlines for every participant.

U-shaped design facilitates seminar discussions and dialogue among participants.

Its fixed design creates a controlled environment ideal for lectures, panels, and formal instruction where visibility and acoustics matter.

Bisconti Room

About the Space

This room offers maximum flexibility, functioning as a single large room or dividing into up to five breakout rooms or lunch areas.

Accordion walls allow for multiple configurations making it well-suited for programs that require simultaneous sessions or group work.

About the Space

This space offers a more intimate setting, defined by subdued lighting, a gas fireplace, and walls lined with books that create a quiet, professional atmosphere.

The environment is well-suited for smaller groups where conversation and engagement are the focus.

Its layout supports both seated discussions and small-format events, making it a strong option for private sessions, working meetings, or evening gatherings.

The space can be configured in many ways, including for receptions, refreshment service, or formal dining, and is often used in conjunction with other room rentals to support the overall event experience.
