




#### McGirt Was A Case About Boundaries . . .

#### ... and about "textualism."

"Ascertaining and following the original meaning of the law before us "is the only 'step' proper for a court of law. . .[t]here is no need to consult extratextual sources when the meaning of a statute's terms is clear." "Under our Constitution, States have no authority to reduce federal reservations lying within their borders. Likewise, courts have no proper role in the adjustment of reservation borders. Only Congress may disestablish a reservation."



# The Muscogee (Creek) Reservation Today






# **Criminal Jurisdiction in Indian Country**

Non-Indian	Non-Indian	State Jurisdiction Only
Non-Indian	Victimless	State Jurisdiction
Indian	Victimless	Federal and Tribal

#### THE U.S. SUPREME COURT'S MONTANA TEST

#### **GENERAL RULE:**

Tribes generally <u>cannot</u> exercise civil regulatory jurisdiction over non-Indians in Indian Country, unless certain circumstances exist.

To exert jurisdiction over non-Indians, an Indian Tribe must meet one of two exceptions:

- 1. When non-Indians enter into consensual relationships such as contracts with the Tribe or its members; or
- 2. When non-Indian's conduct "threatens or has some direct effect on the Tribe's well-being, including the political integrity, the economic security, or the health or welfare of the Tribe."



# **The Current Lessons of McGirt**

- In civil or administrative actions involving the Five Tribes, disestablishment or diminishment of their post-Civil War reservation boundaries will not be found;
- 2. Reliance defenses may be available to prevent the legal effect of the finding of no reservation disestablishment or diminishment.
- *3. Montana* and its two exceptions will be critical when determining the limits of tribal jurisdiction over the conduct of non-Indians on non-Indian-owned fee land within a reservation.
- 4. States, tribes and other interested parties should work together to address uncertainties or concerns arising from the continuance of reservation boundaries from the 1866-era treaties.
- 5. At least with regard to McGirt related legal inquiries, federal courts will apply "textualism" and look to the plain language of statutes.
