The Institute for Energy Law (IEL) provides advanced legal education and exceptional professional opportunities for lawyers and other professionals in the energy industry. Through its programs, publications and membership activities, the Institute offers an important forum on contemporary issues affecting the industry. Since 1949, the Institute's record of achievements has been aided by the participation and support of many of the world's leading companies, lawyers, and energy professionals.

#### **WHY BECOME A MEMBER?**

Members are entitled to serve or to appoint one or more persons to serve on the Institute's Advisory Board, depending on the membership level. Advisory Board members are entitled to tuition-free attendance at the **Annual Oil & Gas Law Conference** and discounted attendance at all other Institute programs. Advisory Board members also have the opportunity to participate in the work of the Institute's practice committees and a variety of free professional and social membership activities.

#### **THE ADVISORY BOARD**

The work of the IEL is done primarily through its Advisory Board and committees. The Advisory Board and its committees meet for business and social activities each February in connection with the Annual Oil & Gas Law Conference. Other committee and conference planning activities occur throughout the year.

#### **PROGRAMS AND PUBLICATIONS**

Each year the Institute for Energy Law offers a two-day **Annual Oil & Gas Law Conference**, which was first presented in 1949 and is now the oldest continuing oil and gas legal education program in the country. Other programs customarily presented annually include an **Energy Litigation Conference; Oilfield Services Law Conference; Law of Shale Plays Conference; Mergers and Acquisitions Conference; National Young Energy Professionals' Law Conference;** regional **Young Energy Professionals' General Counsel Forums;** and a variety of committee CLE programs. The Institute for Energy Law publishes three quarterly e-publications: **The Energy Law Advisor**, a newsletter containing short articles of interest to members as well as industry and member news; the **Oil & Gas E-Report**, an e-publication containing articles of interest to oil and gas practitioners; and **The Energy Dispatch**, IEL's Young Energy Professional newsletter, containing substantive articles on trending legal issues, member highlights, and professional development articles. IEL also maintains a digital library of past conference papers, and, with LexisNexis Matthew Bender, training modules on key fundamentals of energy law practice for in-house use, and the **Proceedings of the Institute on Oil and Gas Law** (since 1949).

#### **YOUNG ENERGY PROFESSIONALS**

The Institute encourages the participation of young lawyers and other professionals under the age of 40. There are a variety of ways for young professionals to join the Institute: by joining individually as an Associate Member and thus joining the Advisory Board; by designation to the Advisory Board by his or her member employer; or by joining individually as a Young Energy Professional Member. Each option entitles young professionals to participate in all programs and other activities of the Institute's Young Energy Professionals Committee (YEP).
