

72nd Annual Oil & Gas Law Conference Moved to April 2021

IEL has moved the 72nd Annual Oil & Gas Law Conference in Houston from its usual February date to April 22-23, 2021 in hopes that the two-month delay will allow the conference to be held in person, in addition to being offered online. Regardless of whether in person attendance is possible, the Conference will take place and be available to attend remotely online on April 22-23, 2021.
