Greg Holliday began his career in policing in September of 1970 with the Dallas Police Department and worked his way through the ranks to the position of Assistant Chief of Police. As Assistant Chief, he commanded the Emergency Operations Center during 9/11 and received many awards including the Departmental Certificate of Merit Award for his work on streamlining the criminal Case Filing System; the Departmental Certificate of Civic Achievement and recognition from the Rotary International District 5810 for Ethics in Business/Government.

Following his retirement from the Dallas Police Department in January of 2002, Greg was the Regional Director of Security for Crescent Real Estate Equities from August of 2003 to September of 2007.
