Directions to San Marcos PD (training location) at 2300 South IH-35, San Marcos, TX 78666:

From Austin: Travel south on IH35 and take Exit 202 (Wonder World Drive/RR12). Remain on the frontage road through the intersection (approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile). Go straight through the intersection and travel approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. Police Headquarters is located on the right/west side.

From San Antonio: Travel north on IH35 and take Exit 202. Before the first intersection, take the turnaround and travel back south on the west frontage road for approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. Police Headquarters is located on the right/west side.

Available lodging:

Several nearby motels (within one exit/mile) offer competitive or government rates for officers attending training. **Be sure to mention that you are attending training at SMPD and that you are a government employee**, if this applies. You may need to complete a tax-exemption form and may need your employer's tax ID number for the form. Listing below is in no order of preference, simply by distance from the training site.
