COURSE OVERVIEW

Using Microsoft Office as a tool, this 2.5 day program will demonstrate the benefits of technology in crime analysis, investigations and community policing. Utilizing exercises similar to projects faced by law enforcement personnel, participants will use Microsoft Access, Excel and PowerPoint in concert to analyze crime patterns, trends and problems.

In order for participants to receive the most benefit from this learning experience, they will be asked to bring a laptop loaded with MS Office Professional* (version 2007 or later) with both Microsoft Excel and PowerPoint. MS Office 2016 (365) would be preferred). If a laptop is not available, the student may share with another student or simply observe the techniques being used in class.
