ITA Academic Winter Meeting and Works-in-Progress Workshop will take place in person, in Detroit, and online, on 15 February 2025.



Small States and Climate Change

In light of COP 28 UN Climate Change Conference in Dubai last year, the Prime Minister of Samoa and Chair of the Alliance of Small Island States (AOSIS), Honourable Fiamē Naomi Mata'afa, observed: "Our islands are being pushed to the brink by the climate crisis and we need a strong plan of action for survival, right now ."

This post discusses climate change redress from the perspective of small island states. It firstly sets out the role of climate change dispute resolution regarding the redress of climate change related challenges. It then asks the question how climate justice can be best achieved for small island states, ie whether claiming redress is the most effective remedy for small island states before offering some concluding remarks.


