CANCELLATION POLICY: Tuition, less a \$50 cancellation fee will be refunded upon receipt of written cancellation received by November 9, 2017. E-mail cancellation notice to lgaspar@cailaw.org. After this date, no refunds, but substitution of attendees for this program will be permitted. Registrants not entitled to a refund will receive the course materials.
