





"The historic Wieliczka Salt Mine is the only site in the world where mining have been continued since the Middle Ages. Lying on nine levels, its original excavations (longitudinals, traverses, chambers, lakes, as well as lesser and major shafts) stretch for a total of 300 kilometres reaching the depth of 327 meters and illustrate all the stages of the development of mining technology over time." - the quotation from September 8th 1978, when Wieliczka Salt Mine, along with 11 other sites from all over the world, joined the UNESCO's very first World Heritage list. The mine is also notable for its long tradition of tourism. The famous breathtaking site has been visited over the centuries by Nicolaus Copernicus, Johann Wolfgang von Goethe, Alexander von Humboldt, Dimitri Mendeleev, Pope John Paul II, and crowned heads of state, not to mention millions of people from all over the world. The tour includes a visit to the stunning "underground town" with lakes, passages, and the marvellous Chapel of St. Kinga.

Magnificent chambers chiselled out in rock salt. Amazing underground saline lakes, majestic timber constructions and unique statues sculpted in salt. Almost 3 kilometres of meandering corridors, 800 steps to go down of which 350 have to be descended to reach the depth of 135 meters underground. Thus, it is no surprise that till now, the Tourist Route - the main visiting route of the mine has been visited by 36,000,000 tourists from around the whole world in search of adventures.



During the tour you will have a chance to visit twenty historic chambers connected by 2 kilometers of passages. Descent into the mine by staircase (380 steps) to the 1 st level (at a depth of 64 meters) and return to the surface by a lift up the Daniłowicz shaft from the 3rd level (at a depth of 135 meters). The whole tour lasts about 4-5 hours. You will spend around 2 hours in the Salt Mine. If you would like to take photos, you have to buy permission at the entrance to the Chapel of St. Kinga. During this tour there is no lunch break. If you have bought a student ticket, please do not forget to bring your student card (please do remember that student tickets are only available for people under the age of 25). After your arrival back in Kraków, you will be dropped off at your pick-up point. Participants who during their reservation have chosen The Pilgrims' or The Miner's Route, visit the mine with their guide following the selected route.



HOW WAS THE SALT MINED AND TRANSPORTED?

For those who want to see the mine from the side of a miner, we offer The Miner's Route. You will have a chance to feel like a miner while following the trail located off the busy touristic routes. You will wear the working clothes, take the mining equipment and learn how to set the path, measure the concentration of methane, dig and transport salt.

The visit is an active expedition and requires increased physical effort.

- The trail does not connect with the Tourist Route and associated chambers (Chapel of Saint Kinga is not included).
- 🔀 Before exploring, you will need to complete some formalities. Please consult the complete documentation.
- The visit is always supervised by a professional guide.
- The expedition is for people aged 12 or older. Children under 12 are to be supervised by a guardian.
- Tourists receive a protective coverall and mining equipment: a lamp, a POG absorber and a helmet.


TAKE A RIDE ON THE UNDERGROUND TRAIN!

Bochnia's undeniable asset is Its unique combination of severity, naturalness and state-of-the-art multimedia expositions which never fall to fascinate visitors. After eight centuries of working, It now has a character of an underground town where you can even take a ride by the underground train, slide down the world's longest underground slide and take an underground ferry ride crossing the brine lake flooding the chamber. The wodden boats are listed in the Polish Register of Ships, just like the sea-sailing ships.

After arrival you will descent into the mine by a miner's lift and explore the route mostly on foot but some parts of the distance are covered by a tourist train. During the tour you will have a chance to explore a network of chambers and galleries with unique shapes and geological structure including a horse stable, woodden treadmill expositions and the Saint Kinga's Chapel which is located at the August Level at a depth of 212 m below ground. It is the largest and the best preserved chapel in the Bochnia Mine. The tour ends In the largest chamber, the Wazyn, where you can slide down the world's longest, 140-metre slide and on Sundays you will have a unique opportunity to enjoy world's only ferry crossing of an underground chamber flooded with brine. At the end you will come up to the surface by the same miner's lift and we will take you back to Krakow.

Explore the oldest Salt Mine in Poland and enjoy the unique opportunity to take a ride on an underground train and a slide down the world's longest, 140-metre slide connecting 2 levels of the mine. Learn about the history of salt mining, the hardships of miners'work as well as the history of Poland thanks to Bochnia's Multimedia Exposition. Want more? Every Sunday we will take you on an underground ferry ride.

AUSCHWITZ - BIRKENAU IS THE SITE OF THE MOST NOTORIOUS MASS MURDER IN THE HISTORY OF HUMANITY. ITS REMNANTS HAVE BEEN MEMORIALISED AND SERVE AS A MIRROR OF THE HUMAN SOUL AND A TOOL FOR SELF-REFLECTION.

Established in 1940 by the Nazis during WW II, Auschwitz was an enormous labour camp and death factory. The name "Auschwitz" comes from the Polish word "Oświęcim," the name of the Polish city near which the camp was built. The complex consists of two main camps: Auschwitz I - the administrative centre - and Auschwitz II (Birkenau) - the extermination camp. The number of people exterminated at the camp has been estimated to be between 1.1 -1.6 million. Most of the victims were killed in the gas chambers using Zyklon B; other deaths were caused by systematic starvation, forced labour, lack of disease control, individual executions and medical experiments. At the end of the war, the SS made great efforts to destroy what remained of the camp, to burn the archives and to murder everyone whom they believed to be the "Bearers of Secrets".

Our Auschwitz-Birkenau Tour gives you the opportunity to learn more about the Holocaust and to see one of the most terrifying, yet also moving places in the world.

VISITING RULES ON THE GROUNDS OF THE AUSCHWITZ-BIRKENAU MUSEUM

- On the Museum grounds, visitors should behave with the appropriate solemnity and respect. Dress should be appropriate for a place of this nature.
- Large items of baggage or backpacks are not permitted on the Museum grounds. The maximum size of baggage, backpacks or purses that visitors may carry on the site is 30x20x10 cm.
- Persons under the influence of alcohol or any other substance, or behaving in a way that violates the commemoration of the victims, endangers the security of the collections, archives, or original camp objects, disturbs other visitors, or violates the accepted norms for public behaviour, are prohibited from entering the Museum grounds.
- No vehicles of any kind are permitted on the Museum grounds except for wheelchairs or in cases where the Museum director has granted permission. Infant carriages and strollers may not be used at the site of the former Auschwitz I camp.
 - · Smoking and the consumption of food and alcohol are prohibited on the Museum grounds.
- All visitors are subject to a security check before and/or after entering the Museum. While on the Museum grounds, visitors must follow instructions from guides and Museum Guards.
 - · No refunds are available after the ticket purchase.
- Visiting the Museum is only available in the language option purchased. No language changes are permitted after the ticket purchase.


ADMIRE THE VIEW OF TATRA MOUNTAINS FROM GUBAŁÓWKA!



LEARN THE FATE OF THE INHABITANTS OF CRACOW DURING THE SECOND WORLD WAR!


Thanks to 1993 film directed by Steven Spielberg, which action takes place in Krakow during World War II, the world became aware of one of the most moving and incredible stories related to World War II.

In June 2010, after years of preparation, The Schindler's Factory Museum opened its doors to the public. The Museum is located in the original Oskar Schindler Enamelled Goods Factory. Visitors are taken back step by step to World War II times learning its history from the beginning up until the arrival of the Soviet Army by walking through rooms filled with memories of Oscar Schindler. The Museum is one of Krakow's most important sites and an essential point for those who want to learn the city's history.

The permanent exhibition "Kraków under Nazi Occupation 1939-1945" lets the visitors learn the story about Krakow and its inhabitants, both Polish and Jewish, during World War II. The narrative begins with the events that took place a month before the War and includes first months of Nazi occupation all the way up to the history of the Krakow's Ghetto and the Płaszów Concentration Camp. Next two rooms are dedicated to the story of Oskar Schindler and 1200 Jews whose lives he saved.

The tour lasts approx. 2 hours with an option to extend the visit by watching the movies and exploring the documents related to the Heroes of this incredible story. Schindler's Factory Museum is a must see for those who want to fully understand the history of World War II and the impact it had on the City of Krakow and its inhabitants. The greatest contribution of the Steven Spielberg's film is that it presents to the world one of the most moving and incredible stories related to World War II. More than a thousand Jews of Krakow owe their lives to one single person: Oskar Schindler.

VISIT THE FAVOURITE DISTRICT OF KRAKOW'S ARTISTS!

The Kazimierz district is the historical Jewish part of Krakow. Its narrow streets and courts are rich in masterpieces of Jewish architecture.

Founded in 1335 by King Kazimierz the Great, the district used to be a separate town altogether.

THE NEW CEMETERY - UL. MIODOWA 55

A place where many of Krakow's distinguished lews were buried in the 19th and 20th centuries.

ISAAC'S SYNAGOGUE - UL.KUPA 18

The renovation of this Jewish Baroque style synagogue is still in progress, yet it is probably the most outstanding and beautiful Jewish monument in Krakow.

POPPER SYNAGOGUE - UL. SZEROKA 16

The Wolf Popper Synagogue used to be one of the most splendid Jewish houses of prayer in the old Jewish quarter of Kazimierz established in a suburb earmarked in 1495 by King Jan I Olbracht. The synagogue was founded by Wolf "The Stork" Popper in early 17th century. Its entrance was once adorned with open-work doors depicting four animals: an eagle, a leopard, a lion, and a buck deer, which symbolise the main traits of a devout man.

TEMPEL SYNAGOGUE - UL. MIODOWA 24

The Tempel Synagogue was built in 1860-1862. It was designed after the Leopoldstadter Tempel, in Vienna, Austria. At the time the synagogue was built, Krakow was part of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. The synagogue was ruined during World War II by the German Nazis, who used the building as an ammunition storage area. A large inflow of financial contributions from private donors around the world allowed the synagogue to undergo a vast renovation from 1995 until 2000. It is still active today, although formal prayers are held only a few times a year.

THE OLD SYNAGOGUE - UL.SZEROKA 24

The oldest remaining example of Jewish architecture in Poland. Built in the early 1500's, it is now the site of many exhibitions devoted to Polish Judaism.

This is a 17th-century synagogue, developed from a neighbourhood earmarked in 1495 by King Jan I Olbracht for the Jewish community, which has been transferred from the budding Old Town. Kupa Synagogue serves Krakow's Jewish community as one of the venues for religious ceremonies and cultural festivals, notably the annual Jewish Culture Festival in Krakow.

The Remuh Synagogue is the smallest of all historic synagogues of the Kazimierz district of Krakow. It is currently one of two active synagogues in the city.

High Synagogue is an inactive Orthodox Jewish synagogue. It was called the High (or Tall) Synagogue for many centuries for it was the tallest synagogue in the city. It was built in 1556-1563. During the occupation of Poland in World War II, Nazis stripped the interior of all equipment. The ceiling and roof were destroyed. High Synagogue serves as a Landmark Conservation building. Since 2005 it has been open to visitors. Photographic and other exhibitions about customs and traditions of the Jewish community of the Interwar period are staged indoors.

During this walking tour, you will have an opportunity to see the Kazimierz district with plenty of romantic small cafes, which have made it the centre of artistic life in Krakow. The hot spot surrounded by buildings that witnessed horrors of the Holocaust is also a place where Jewish culture has flourished for centuries. Incidentally, the Kazimierz district was a film set for Steven Spielberg's Oscar-winning "Schindler's List". Then, we will go to the district of Podgórze to see the Schindler's factory (admission is not included in the tour price) and the surviving remnants of the Krakow ghetto from World War II.

There will be also time for: a 1/2 hour coffee break to discuss the social and economic situation in Poland | funny stories and legends, customs and traditions.

THE CITY OF POLISH KINGS!

See the beauty of the Old Town with its original medieval street layout, marvellous architecture, and unique atmosphere that distinguishes Krakow from the rest of Poland. As the former capital of Poland, it has a rich history which is still visible even today.

The highlight of the Old Town, which begins at St. Florian's Church in the northern part of the Medieval Old Town, runs along Floriańska, Grodzka, and Kanonicza Street, and ends at the Wawel Castle - the old residence of Polish monarchs, which was built in the 14th century. With a large number of prominent historic landmarks on its way, the Royal Road is a true reminder of the golden age in Krakow's history.

The basilica was built in the 13th century in place of the previous one which was destroyed during one of the Tatar invasions. Inside, you will find works of the most prominent artists in this region of Europe. The magnificent altarpiece by Veit Stoss and the polychrome paintings by Matejko, Mehoffer and Wyspiański are just some of them.

THE CHURCH OF ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISIAT - 2 FRANCISZKAŃSKA STREET

The Roman Catholic religious church on the west side of the All Saints' Square, across the street from the Bishop's Palace - residence of Pope John Paul II during his stays in the city. The church dates back to the 13th century. Saint Maximilian Kolbe was a monk there in 1919 and led his first service at this church upon Poland's return to sovereignty.

A 50m-high rocky hill on the edge of the old town located on the bank of the Vistula River. On the top, you will see the most important monument in Poland - the Wawel Castle. The building is a mixture of the Medieval, Romanesque, Renaissance

and Baroque styles. Up until the 17th century, the castle was the seat of the Polish royal power. One of the most important parts of the historical structure is the cathedral, which is full of chapels, tombs and sarcophagi. While visiting Wawel Hill do not forget to enter the royal chambers and the armoury. The cord in front of the cathedral offers a beautiful view of the Sigismund Chapel with its gold covered roof.

SS PETER & PAUL'S CHURCH - 54 GRODZKA STREET

The most important Jesuit church in the city. Built at the beginning of the 17th century, it has been rebuilt a few times and its current appearance is much different from the original one.


This 14th-century building was rebuilt after the conflagration in 1555 and it is a splendid edifice of the Renaissance. Some of the structures, such as the arcades or the central transepts, were added in the late 1800s.

During this walking tour, you will have an opportunity to see Wawel Hill, the royal castle and the cathedral, the Old Town, the Jagiellonian University district, the Planty Park, the Main Market Square, St. Mary's Basilica and remnants of fortifications.
